This week the IG2 parents and students attended an A Level information evening. The parents and students learnt what A Levels are and how respected the CAIE qualification is around the world.

Ms Ali our KS4 Coordinator discussed the transition from IGCSE to A Level- which all teachers agreed is huge. Mr MacDonald and Ms Chen (our dedicated University Counsellors) discussed the next steps for making choices between subjects- bearing in mind the impact this choice can have on future university applications. Mr Colton our Key Stage 5 Coordinator discussed the importance of life balance – the world beyond school, and how important it is to be able to demonstrate soft skills as well as academic ones. He then introduced us to some of the current personal projects being undertaken by A level students now (see below for some examples of our Student Leaders in action).

I would like to take the opportunity to explain a couple of procedures.
