Dear Parents.

This week I would like to focus on our Post 16 provision. This is possibly the most important part of our young people's educational journey- as decisions made at this level can open up so many opportunities in the future. So this edition will focus on updating you on our A1 and A2 students.

It has been a busy time of year for the university and careers guidance counseling department, and there is a lot of good news to share:

Our A2 students, the second cohort of SUIS Pudong students to have gone through this painstaking and often stressful process, have received the majority of their offers and will be attending an interesting and diverse range of institutions next year.

Recent weeks have seen two particularly noteworthy milestones: the school's first ever university offers from the United States, and its first ever art school acceptances. Karen Chiwandamira will be attending her first-choice option next year, the University of Utah, while A-Level art students Cherry Chen and Sophie Ding have both received offers from Maryland Institute College of Art.

Cherry has also received an offer from Savannah College of Art and Design, who offered her both a place at the university and a generous scholarship after she impressed them at an interview. Seth Dong, the only student applying to the UK this year, has received offers to study astrophysics from some of the leading universities in the UK, including Leeds, Sheffield, Liverpool and Surrey, adding to the eye-catching list of British institutions to have been impressed by the calibre of our students.

Congratulations are in order to all of these students, after all the hard work they put into their applications.

While university applications are not made until the students' final year of school, the earlier they prepare for this crucial period of time the better. With this is mind, we have been holding one-on-one sessions with all IG2 and A1 students to discuss their future plans in more detail, and it has been incredibly pleasing to see how thoroughly prepared they are.

The IG2 students are clear about which A-Levels to choose and what steps they need to take once their IGCSEs are completed, while the A1 cohort are already identifying which universities to apply to, and working on strengthening their applications well ahead of time. In addition, the students of IG1 and IG2 have started to attend bi-monthly university counseling sessions, in which they have been introduced to the key features of the world's leading university systems and what they can do now to benefit their applications in future.

Last but not least, we are delighted to be able to share the recently-completed SUIS Pudong University Application Handbook, a comprehensive 23-page document which we hope will answer the majority of questions students and parents may have. The Handbook is available in both English and Chinese, and we would recommend that students and parents in IG1 have a look through it and discuss its contents as a family.

Extra-Curricular Activities:

We all know that universities require good grades but they also want to see our students as 'people' too, they want to see that our young people are taking on leadership roles, imlemnting ideas and doing things for themselves. To this end our current A1 have been working veru hard on their personal projects, have a look below.

The A Level Personal Project

Alongside their academic subjects, A1 students are encouraged to identify, plan, carry out and evaluate at least one full scale project of their choice. This allows each individual the chance to investigate an area of passion in greater detail adding value to their educational journey and eventually their university application.

Along with a growing number of schools worldwide, SUIS Pudong provides a BridgeU account to all students from IG1 and up, in order to help them research their university options, strengthen their personal statement preparation and manage their applications. From what was discussed at the event, BridgeU's already excellent service looks set to improve yet further, with improved integration with the American Common App application system and an increase in university data to include countries such as Germany due for release soon. The event also gave the assembled counselors a great opportunity to network and share ideas.

The A1 students' active use of the BridgeU university search and shortlist function has allowed the University and Careers Guidance Counseling team to have some very productive discussions with them in their recent one-on-one meetings, and we encourage all of our IGCSE and A-Level students to continue making full use of this fantastic service. Dear Parents,

G7, A1 and A2 Parent-Student-Teacher 3-Way Conference will be held on **Tuesday 26 March 2019**, **starting at 16:30 and ending at 19:45**. Parents need to sign up for the meeting(s) through SUIS Pudong online system. The signing up period will run from **18 March** at 9 am through to the evening of 24 March (closes at midnight).

Online Booking Procedures - Please carefully read and follow these instructions:

- 1. Use the following link: http://app.suis-pd.com/istas
- 2. Select the grade of your child.
- 3. Select the date: 2019-3-26.
- 4. Input your child's first and last name in English in the cell of 'Student Name', e.g. Smith JOHN.
- 5. Click the cell of 'Teacher' with whom you want to book the meeting. The entire row will turns into grey. Select a meeting time (meeting start time) that is available. Please be reminded that we will adjust the time slot for each meeting to 5 minutes this time. For example, if you succeed in selecting "16:30", it means that the meeting time is "16:30-16:35". If scheduling permits, please do not book consecutive meetings to allow for travel time between meetings.
- 6. After clicking the time available, it will show if your booking is successful.
- 7. If you want to book another meeting, click "Go back" to repeat steps 5 & 6.
- 8. Given the importance of each subject studied at A Level, Level parents of A1 and A2 students in these grades are permitted to book two consecutive slots i.e. 10 minutes for each subject.
- 9. In order to have a final check for all the meetings you have booked, click 'Search' next to your child's name. All of your bookings will be displayed. We suggest you save a screenshot or write them down. Please note that this action is very important as a confirmation of successful bookings and it helps you to find each teacher's location on the meeting day, which will be displayed at the school lobby.
- 10. If you change a booking time with a teacher due to a change of your plan, please remember to cancel the old booking by emailing the Secondary Secretary Ms. Cici Ye (ciciy.pd@suis.com.cn) so that another parent can take that time. You will then follow the steps 1 to 8 to book the meeting(s) again.

Please note that if you have already made an appointment with the teacher, you do not need to book the schedule online again. If you experience any problems using the system, please telephone Ms. Cici Ye at 58869990 ext. 209. If you need any support on translation for the meetings, please arrange for your own translators.

Please note the following important information:

- School will end at 15:50 as normal **Tuesday 26 March 2019**, but we strongly encourage Secondary students to attend this Parent-Student-Teacher 3-Way Conference in the best interests of their education.
- You are not expected to meet all teachers. Meetings are booked on a "first come first served" basis. If you do want to meet some teachers but the time is unavailable, please schedule the meetings on another day by emailing the relevant teachers directly.

On **Tuesday 26 March 2019**, please enter from the school gate on Xue Ye Road. If you drive to school, please use the parking lot at the corner of Xueye road and Hongshan road. When you arrive at the school, registration will be required at the reception area in the school lobby, where you will find the teachers' location. We look forward to seeing you at the Parent-Student-Teacher Meeting.
