As you are aware the KS3 and IG1 exams begin on Monday, we wish all of our students the best of luck, do prepare and revise but also look after yourselves!

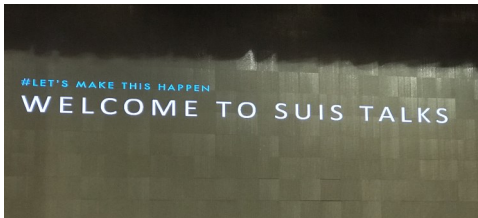


Student Voice News
