New School Year Primary Orientation Day (Student/Parent/Teacher Meeting on 26 August 2019)

Dear Parents.

For the new school year 2019-20, the Primary orientation day will be held on Monday 26 August 2019. It will be open to all students. To help the students and parents know more about the new class routine and the homeroom teachers, we will have the Student/Parent/Teacher Meeting on the orientation day. Parents need to sign up for the meeting(s) through SUIS Pudong online system. The signing up period will run from Wednesday, 87 August at 78am midday through to the midday of Friday, 23 August (closes at 12:00 midday).

Online Booking Procedures - Please carefully read and follow these instructions:

- 1. Use the following link http://app.suis-pd.com/istap
- 2. Select the class of your child for school year 2019-20. Information for the new class should have been released on Thursday.
- 3. Select the date: 2019-08-26.
- 4. Input your child's first and last name in English (<u>not in Chinese</u>) in the cell of 'Student Name', e.g. SMITH John.
- 5. Click the cell of 'Homeroom Teachers'. The entire row will turns into grey. Select a meeting time (meeting start time) that is available. Each meeting will be 15 minutes. For example, if you succeed in selecting "9:15", it means that the meeting time is "9:15-9:30".
- 6. After clicking the time available, it will show if your booking is successful.
- 7. In order to have a final check for the meeting you have booked, click 'Search' next to your child's name. Your booking will be displayed. We suggest you save a screenshot or write it down. Please note that this action is very important as a confirmation of successful bookings and it helps you to find each teacher's location on the meeting day, which will be displayed at the school lobby.
- 8. If you want to change a booking time with the homeroom teachers due to a change of your plan, please remember to cancel the old booking by emailing to Primary Secretary Ms. Yevan Shao (yevans.pd@suis.com.cn) so that another parent can take that time. You will then follow the step 1 to 7 to book the meeting again.
- 9. For sibling's parent/teacher/student meeting, please repeat step 1-7.

Please note that this is the only way to schedule the Student/Parent/Teacher Meeting on 26 <u>August.</u> If you experience any problems using the system, please telephone Ms. Yevan at 5886 9990 ext.: 303 on work days from 21 August to 23 August (9am-3:30pm).

Please note the following important information:

When you arrive at the school, registration will be required at the reception area in the school lobby, where you will find homeroom location.
