Uniform Policy

As the school year progresses, it is often the case that students uniform starts to become older, too small or lost. In order to maintain our standards and consistency, please ensure that your child is wearing the correct items and that they are of a good, clean standard.

<u>Formal uniform</u>: Pleated skirt, or tailored trousers/shorts, white long/short-sleeved shirt, V- neck sleeveless pullover, blazer, sweatshirt jacket, a tie, school coat, smart black footwear. Skirts must be at an appropriate length; socks must not be worn higher than the knee. Socks should be black, white or grey only. No logos or printing other than the school badge on clothing, socks or shoes.

<u>Daily uniform</u>: Pleated skirt, or tailored trousers/shorts, white long/short-sleeved shirt, V- neck sleeveless pullover, SUIS jumper, sweatshirt jacket, a tie, school coat, black footwear (no bright colours, logos, laces, trims, boots above the knee are also not acceptable). Skirts must be at an appropriate length; socks must not be worn higher than the knee. Socks should be black, white or grey only. No logos or printing other than the school badge on clothing, socks or shoes.

<u>Sportswear</u>: Short-sleeved T-shirt, long-sleeved polo shirt, shorts and school jogging pants. Sports shoes must be worn. Sportswear is only for days when students have school PE or physical CCA. For after school PE clubs, students should change into their sportswear after school.

We would like to thank you all for your support and cooperation in this matter. Please remember to put a note in your child's planner if there are unable to come into school with the correct uniform.
