We look forward to next year when we can offer parents the same chance. To come and observe, to watch their children learn and experience a small part of life at school, is a privilege for all.




# Grade 7 Renaissance History Project

This semester in History, our Grade 7 junior historians have been learning about the Renaissance. The Renaissance was a period in European history that marked the transition from the Middle

## A2 Psychology Research Trip

In A2 Psychology, students have been learning about Consumer Psychology - the research behind the choices shoppers make and how shops use this research to increase sales.



On Friday the 9th of April our students headed to the nearby River Mall to conduct their own research in a field setting. One group used a light meter to measure the impact of environmental variables on shopper behaviour in a range of different shops. The other group approached shoppers to ask about their experience of using menus on paper or using their phones and got some unexpected responses!



After two years of evaluating the research of other famous psychologists, the students gained valuable experience of conducting their own research and learnt some useful lessons. They learnt how sometimes research needs to be adapted during the data gathering process so flexibility is important, and also how difficult it can be to approach members of the public to ask them to be participants.

The afternoon was really positive and the students are looking forward to sharing their results and conclusions in class this week.
