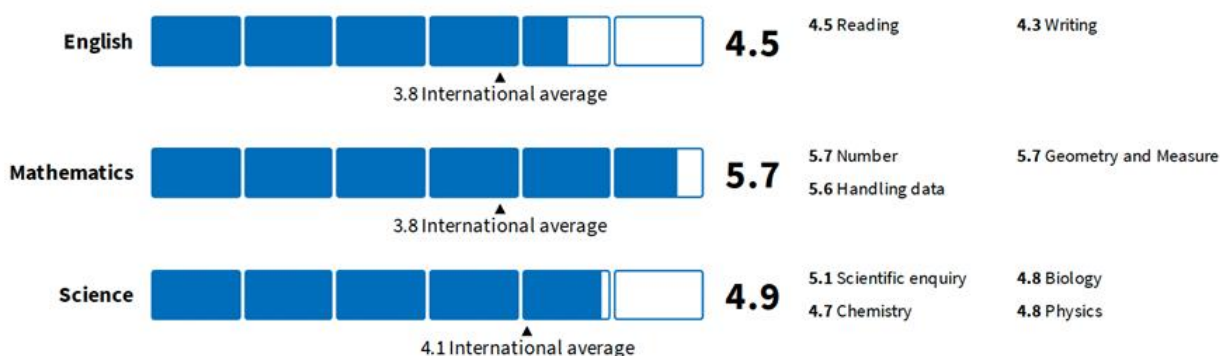


Exam Results for Primary

In April 2021, our Grade 5 students took part in the Cambridge Primary Checkpoint Examinations. After waiting patiently, we are tremendously honoured to present our outstanding results with you. Overall, our students performed exceptionally well and should be very proud of their learning. Out of a possible 6 within Cambridge's scale, we scored a 4.5 in English and 4.9 in Science, indicating very good levels of achievement with a complete and sound understanding of the Cambridge curriculum. For both English and Science, our students scored much higher than the international average, which was 3.8 in English and 4.1 for Science. In Maths, we achieved a highly impressive result with a of 5.7 out of a possible 6, indicating an excellent level of achievement with a comprehensive and secure understanding of the Cambridge knowledge and curriculum. Once again, our students are some of the most highly capable Maths students as we scored much higher in Maths than the international average of 3.8. 14 students achieved a score of 6 across all 3 subjects. We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate our students for their excellent results and remarkable hard work throughout their schooling.

COVID Protocols

According to the latest epidemic prevention requirements released by the local authorities, all students are advised not to leave Shanghai and not to go to high- and medium- risk areas in China or traveling overseas unless necessary. Those who come or return to Shanghai from high- or medium- risk areas in China, should report to their local community committees, schools (or hotels) within 12 hours of their arrival in Shanghai. Students who are currently out of Shanghai are advised to take epidemic prevention measures in accordance with relevant national and local requirements. All students are required to carry out 14-day health observation in Shanghai before returning to school. As the epidemic situation continues to change, epidemic prevention requirements will be subject to the latest requirements of relevant departments. In order to ensure the health and safety of all the students and staff, if you're leaving Shanghai, please make sure you scan the following QR code and complete the form on the day you arrive back in Shanghai. The blue one is in Chinese and the green one is in English, you will only need to complete one of them.



School Uniform

We are writing to inform you that in the new academic year 2021-2022, all International Secondary School Students on the Pudong Campus will be expected to wear formal school uniform every day, with the exception of PE and CCA days. This will involve wearing the formal school blazer instead of the hooded jumper and black school shoes instead of trainers, see the picture below for guidance.

If your child does not already have all uniform items, please make sure that you purchase these before the start of the new school year. You will need to purchase this directly from our uniform supplier: <http://www.graceuniform.com.cn/>

Please note the following;

- *Only plain navy blue, white, black and grey socks/tights are permitted. No designs particularly white/coloured stripes*
- *Students should not wear leggings instead of socks or tights*
- *All students must wear a school tie*
- *On PE days students will only be permitted to wear black, plain trainers without designs*

Please note, we expect all students to look smart and presentable at all times. All uniform items should be of a suitable length and size.

Absence Reporting

Students must attend school regularly and be punctual. Good attendance enhances the chances of success in school and in the work force. The attendance information is issued in the semester reports.

- For sickness absences, on the day of illness, parents will need to complete the form on the ISAMs Parent Portal before 8am on the day of absence.
- If your child's absence exceeds 3 days, you will need to email your child's form tutor the medical note or send them into school with a copy of this.
- For planned Leave of Absence, you will need to inform the school by completing the form on the ISAMs Parent Portal as early as possible. Evidence related to the request will need to be sent to your child's form tutor and grade coordinator.
- If you having trouble accessing Parent Portal and email must be sent to their form tutor.

If your son or daughter needs to leave school early please contact form tutor or Admin staff.

When a student returns to school, he/she should find out what work was missed and complete it within a reasonable amount of time, as decided by the teachers.
