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This semester also saw the launch of our Secondary reward qualities, these were devised by the Pastoral Team last semester and embodies all the characteristics that we expect to see from our students.






Cambridge Checkpoint May 2021

We would like to share our outstanding exam results with you again.

In April 2021, our Grade 5 students took part in the Cambridge Primary Checkpoint Examinations. After waiting patiently, we are tremendously honoured to present our outstanding results with you. Overall, our students performed exceptionally well and should be very proud of their learning. Out of a possible 6 within Cambridge's scale, we scored a 4.5 in English and 4.9 in Science, indicating very good levels of achievement with a complete and sound understanding of the Cambridge curriculum. For both English and Science, our students scored much higher than the international average, which was 3.8 in English and 4.1 for Science. In Maths, we achieved a highly impressive result with a of 5.7 out of a possible 6, indicating an excellent level of achievement with a comprehensive and secure understanding of the Cambridge knowledge and curriculum. Once again, our students are some of the most highly capable Maths students as we scored much higher in Maths than the international average of 3.8. 14 students achieved a score of 6 across all 3 subjects. We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate our students for their excellent results and remarkable hard work throughout their schooling.

Uniform Reminder

Please be reminded of the updated uniform policy for IS students for the 2021-2022 academic year:

- Students must wear the correct uniform and follow the expected dress code at all times.
- Girl's uniform: Skirt or trousers, white long/short-sleeved shirt, V-neck pullover, blazer, a tie, a winter coat, black shoes and black boots in winter (no white soles or trainers).
- Boy's uniform: Trousers, shorts, white long/short-sleeved shirt, V-neck pullover, blazer, a tie, a winter coat, black shoes (no white soles or sneakers) and black boots in winter. No bright colours or trims. No clothing that is not school issued uniform.
- Sportswear: Short or long-sleeved polo shirt, shorts, jogging pants and jacket.
- Only Navy blue, White, Black and Grey socks/tights are permitted.
- Students should not wear leggings instead of socks or tights.
- Boys should use the long ties and girls should have the short ties.
- If a student will be out of uniform, parents will need to contact the school in advance and provide the reason and the date by which the student will be back in full uniform, either via email to the student's tutor, or with a note in the student's planner.

How to request absences:

On the tab 'Electronic Forms', click 'Leave Request'.
