Computer Science Week 2021

December $13^{th} - 17^{rd}$ was the ISP Computer Science Week. Students, teachers as well as the parents linked together online and have a lot of fun activities during this week.

We hold a class competition on Seesaw to try the maximum possibility to engage the students with the support of the high technology, and look forward to what the future classroom will look like.

Grade 1 students practised the robotic technology with the Beebots. By building their own maps and setting up different routines for the robots, they learned the various ways to translate the algorithm into a runnable program.



Grade 2 & 3 students played a Robot Turtle board game to deepen their programming and communication skills through the team work. The "Turtle Mover" in each team act as a ROBOT to execute the Code Card Decks designed by their "Turtle Masters" to collect as much diamond as possible and fight for the team.














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Grade 4 & 5 students explored the agile development process by building their own Micro:bit Car. They experienced the different roles such as a user, designer, programmer, tester and reporter in a team to practice their planning, communication, cooperation, and time management skills besides the programming skills.









During the PSHE lesson time, Grade 1 students gained some knowledge about the way to keep their personal information safe. Grade 2 students were aware of that information they put online left a digital footprint. Grade 3 students learned what cyberbullying is and how to address it. Grade 4 students practiced the way to use a search engine accurately. Grade 5 students learned how to identify spam emails and what to do with them.


